**September 17th, Sunday, 10:15am: *First scheduled Motor Coach Bus will be available to transport 55 guests per trip from Club 164 to Sandy Point State Park.*** If you are not carpooling to the event, we ask you to use the Motor Coach Bus for transportation, as parking is very limited. The schedule of departure times from Club 164 and from the Sandy Point State Park are listed below. Folding beach chairs, umbrellas, and bags will fit in the storage area of the Motor Coach. We encourage anyone with children requiring a car seat or booster seat to drive or carpool to Sandy Point State Park.

- Swimming and Beach open to all with no lifeguard on duty
